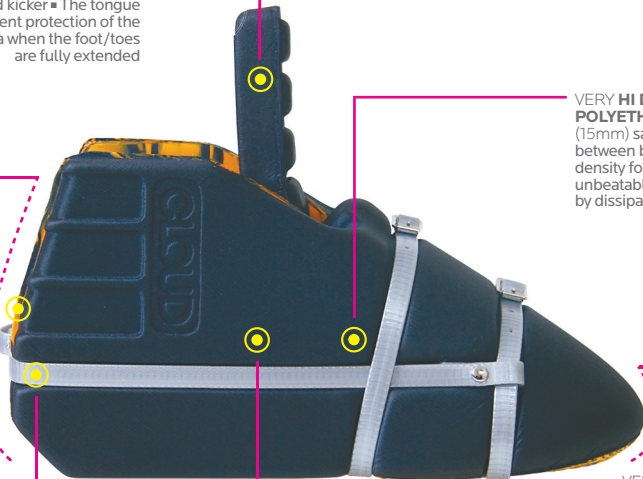

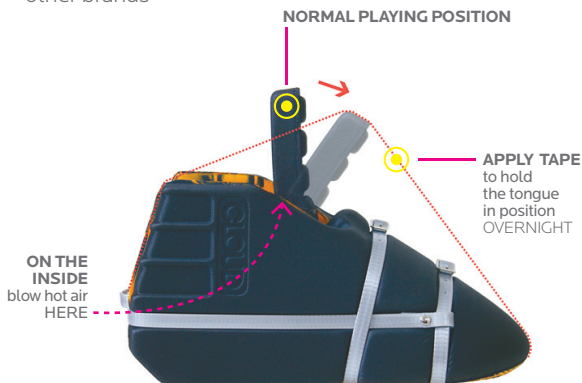
■ Do not cut with a knife or sharp blade.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR CLOUD KICKER TONGUE MORE COMFORTABLE

The tongue on your CLOUD Kicker is designed to provide heaps of protection and contribute to the non-twisting performance of your OBO Legguards when sliding ■ To achieve this, the tongue needs to be quite stiff, but some players find it pushes against the shin and causes discomfort. **If this happens we suggest the following...**

- Tighten up your front kicker straps as you would when setting up to play.
- **Bend the tongue forward** from its usual upright position (that is) **overbend it forward**. Apply a strong tape to hold it in this position.
- With the tongue held forward by the tape, use a hair dryer to **apply heat at the bend point on the inside**. NOT THE OUTSIDE.
- Apply the heat for approximately 3 minutes holding the hair dryer about 8cm (3") away from the surface of the foam tongue.
- **Leave the tongue taped in this position** OVERNIGHT.

This should reduce the pressure of the tongue on your shin, but not reduce protection or anti-twist performance.

S 3 - 5½ (UK) ■ 35 - 38 (EURO)

M 5½ - 8½ (UK) ■ 38 - 42 (EURO)

L 8½ - 12 (UK) ■ 42 - 46 (EURO)
